Day 01	Depart Kuala Lumpur to Cairo, Egypt	Meals on Board
Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for our flight to Amman then connecting flight to Cairo, Egypt.		
Day 02	Cairo, Egypt	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cave Church (Monastery of St Simon) – a massive cave church of Cairo’s Zabbaleen Community. • Ben Ezra Synagogue is where baby Moses was hidden and subsequently found by Pharaoh’s daughter (<i>Exodus 2: 1-10</i>). • Church of Abu Serga (St. Sergious) is where the Holy Family, Joseph, Mary and baby Jesus took shelter in Egypt (<i>Matthew 2: 13-15</i>). • The Hanging Church / Staircase Church, one of the oldest churches in Egypt. • Monastery and Virgin Mary Church where the “Floating Bible” is on a display – “<i>Blessed be Egypt my people</i>”. 		
Check in and overnight at hotel in Cairo .		
Day 03	Cairo, Egypt	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Sphinx and the Pyramid of King Cheops (Khufu), Chepren (Khafre), Mekurinos (Menkaure) phenomenal, one of the <i>Seven Wonders of the Ancient World</i>. • Cruise along the Nile River. • Learn about preparation and characteristics of Essential Oils. • The Museum of Egyptian Antiquities (the Museum of Cairo) is home to an extensive 160,000 collection of ancient Egyptian antiquities covering 5000 years of Egypt’s past. 		
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Cairo .		
Day 04	Cairo to St. Catherine, Egypt	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Suez Canal, an artificial sea-level waterway in Egypt, connecting the Mediterranean Sea to the Red Sea through the Isthmus of Suez. • Marah (Exodus 15: 22 - 25; Number 33: 8-9) is where Moses, under divine direction, cast into the fountain "<i>a certain tree</i>" which took away its bitterness, so that the people drank of it. • Passed-by: Elim (Exodus 15: 27 and Numbers 33: 9) is a place where "<i>there were twelve wells of water and seventy date palms</i>". • The biblical Mount Sinai was the place where Moses received the Ten Commandments from God. (<i>Optional and on self-account: Mount Sinai Sunset Climbing.</i>) 		
Check in and overnight at hotel in St. Catherine .		
Day 05	St. Catherine, Egypt to Jerusalem/Bethlehem	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transfer to Taba, a small Egyptian town near the northern tip of the Gulf of Aqaba, for lunch. • Cross the Taba Border to enter into Eliat – Israel's southernmost city, a busy port and popular resort. 		
Check in and dinner at hotel in Jerusalem/Bethlehem .

Day 06	Jerusalem	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Mount of Olives is one of the most important sites in Jerusalem and played a central role in the life of Jesus. • The Chapel of the Ascension (Luke 24: 50-53) is where Jesus ascended to heaven 40 days after his resurrection. • The Church of the Pater Noster/Church of Eleona is where Jesus would teach his disciples, including the Lord's Prayer (Luke 11: 1-4, Matthew 6: 5-15). • The Church of Dominus Flevit (meaning "The Lord Wept") is where Jesus prophesized the destruction of Jerusalem and wept (Luke 19: 41-44). • The Church of All Nations, site of the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26: 36-56, Luke 22: 39-53) is where Jesus spent his final night and pray alone before his arrest. • The Church of Nativity / Grotto of The Nativity in Bethlehem - the cave in which Jesus of Nazareth was born (Matthew 1: 18-24). • The Shepherds' Field is where the Angel of the Lord visited the shepherds and announced the birth of Jesus (Luke 2: 8-10). 		
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem/Bethlehem .		
Day 07	Jerusalem	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mount Moriah / Temple Mount is where Jesus was presented in the Temple and where He stayed behind to debate with the teachers many years later (Luke 2 : 22-50). • The Pool at Bethesda is where Jesus told a paralytic man to "Stand up, take your mat and walk", and immediately he was made well (John 5: 2-18). • The Via Dolorosa Route (Way of Sorrows) incorporating 14 Stations of the Cross that identify with the suffering of Jesus between His condemnation by Pilate and His crucifixion and burial. • The last five Stations of the Cross are situated inside the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. The Tomb of Christ, the 14th Station of the Cross, is where Jesus lay buried for three days before His resurrection. • The Garden Tomb, a tranquil environment for prayer and reflection on Christ's life. 		
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem/Bethlehem .		
Day 08	Jerusalem	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ein Karem – birth places of John the Baptist — who announced the coming of Jesus Christ, his cousin (Luke 1: 5-24, 39-66) • Holocaust History Museum – Yad Vashem, Israel's official memorial to the Jewish victims of the Nazi Holocaust (or Israel Museum). 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Western Wall (Wailing Wall) is the holiest site in the world for the Jewish people. • The Cenacle room on Mount Zion is commemorating: The Last Supper (The Upper Room) and the coming of the Holy Spirit on the apostles at Pentecost. • Tomb of King David — the celebrated Old Testament warrior king of Israel who is traditionally credited with composing many of the Psalms. 		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu which commemorates the apostle Peter's triple denial of his Master, his immediate repentance and his reconciliation with Christ after the Resurrection. 		
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem/Bethlehem .		



Day 09	Jerusalem	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jericho (City of Palms). The oldest town on earth and also the lowest – more than 250 metres below sea level. • View of Mount of Temptation – traditionally regarded as the mountain on which Christ was tempted by the devil during his 40-day fast. • The rocktop fortress of Masada – a symbol of resistance for the people of Israel. • Qumran, which is famous as the hiding place of the Dead Sea Scrolls. • The Dead Sea is lowest point on earth. <p>Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem/Bethlehem.</p>		
Day 10	Jerusalem to Tiberias	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jaffa is famous for its association with the biblical stories of Jonah, Solomon and St Peter. • Drive through Tel Aviv –the economic and technological center of Israel. • Passed-by Caesarea Maritima ("by the sea"), where the apostle Peter baptised the first recorded gentile convert to Christianity — Cornelius. • The Summit of Mount Carmel (Al Muhraqa) is where Elijah triumphs over the priests of Baal (1 Kings 18: 1-40). • Nazareth is the home town of Jesus (Luke 2: 52). • Church of Annunciation – home of the Virgin Mary. <p>Check in and dinner at hotel in Tiberias.</p>		
Day 11	Tiberias	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sea of Galilee is where Jesus rebuked the winds and the sea (Matthew 8: 23-27), taught from Peter's boat (Luke 5: 3), and walked on water (Mark 6: 45-52). • Mount of Beatitudes is where Jesus delivered the famous "Sermon on the Mount" (Matthew 5-7; Luke 6). • Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes at Tabgha is where Christ's miraculous multiplication of loaves and fish to feed a multitude (Mark 6: 35-44). • The Church of the Primacy of Peter is where Jesus' reinstatement of Peter: "feed my lambs... tend my sheep... feed my sheep." (John 21: 15-19). • Capernaum was the Centre of Jesus' Galilean ministry (Matthew 4: 13). • Yardenit, Jordan River is a modern baptismal site along the Jordan River. • Diamond Factory – a leading diamond polishing center. <p>Dinner and overnight at hotel in Tiberias.</p>		
Day 12	Tiberias to Amman, Jordan	B/L/D
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cana in Galilee is the scene of Jesus' first miracle — the changing of water into wine (John 2: 1-11). • The baptismal site of Bethany Beyond the Jordan (John 1: 28) is believed to be the actual site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist, the act that launched Jesus' public ministry. • Sheik Hussein Border to cross to Jordan for Amman. • (If time permit) Madaba – the City of Mosaics. Visit Church of St George to learn Madaba Mosaic Map and Madaba Institute for Mosaic Art. • (If time permit) Mount Nebo is where Moses viewed the Promised Land of Canaan (Deut. 32: 48-52). • Brief city tour of Amman, the capital of Jordan. • Farewell dinner. <p>Transfer to Amman's Queen Alia International Airport for your departure</p>
