DAY 02	ARRIVAL TO ISTANBUL	B, L, D	

- Arrived Istanbul, meet and assist by our English-speaking guide.
- A full day city tour of Istanbul, the biggest and greatest city in Turkey.
- Visit the **Hippodrome**, where chariot races and the Byzantine riots took place.
- The Mosque of Sultan Ahmet. Beautifully decorated with 21,000 blue Iznik tiles, it is commonly known today as the **Blue Mosque**.
- Visit the world famous Hagia Sophia, the Church of Divine Wisdom and once the biggest church of the Christian World. You will certainly be astonished by the unique mosaics and marble decorations.
- Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.



- Take a flight to **Antakya** (Antioch).
- Visit **Antioch**, where the people of The Way were first named Christians, is bound to make you feel home, in the heart of holiness as Antakya served as the home base for St. Paul's missionary journeys. Peter was the first to establish a church in Antioch (Acts 9:32 and Galatians 2:1 1).
- Visit the **Cave Church** where St. Peter first celebrated mass.
- Visit the Hatay Museum, which is the home for the richest, most varied collection of Greek and Roman mosaics.
- Visit **Seleucia Peria** mentioned in the New Testament as the port, from which Paul and Barnabas set sail for Asia Minor on their first missionary journey.
- Drive to Adana for dinner and overnight.

ADANA - TARSUS - CAPPADOCIA DAY 04 B. L. D

- Visit **Tarsus**, where St. Paul was born, pay a meaningful visit to **St.** Paul's church and St. Paul's well, believed to have healing properties.
- Drive to **Cappadocia**, is a region that is as inspirational as it is
- Visit **Devrent and Monk's Valley**, to see the extraordinary mushroom-shaped rock pinnacles or 'fairy chimneys'.
- Visit the Goreme Open Air Museum, where you will enjoy the fantastic rock churches and beautiful frescos from various centuries decorating the walls of the churches.
- Visit **UchisarCastle**, which is the highest and the most dominant point, giving us a breathtaking panorama.
- See the local stones like **Sultanite and Turquoise** and have some free time for shopping.













Dinner and overnight in Cappadocia.

- See tile and carpet ateliers and have some time for shopping before drive to Konya.
- **Konya** an ancient city in central Turkey once known as Iconium. The site of one of the first church councils and one of the missionary destinations of St. Paul and capital of the Seljuk Empire from 1150 to 1300. Paul preached here on his first missionary journey.

• Dinner and overnight in Konya.

DAY 06 KONYA - LYSTRA -ANTIOCH OF PISIDIA - PAMUKKALE

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
- Drive to Lystra, where Paul preached on his first missionary journey (Acts 14: 6-22).
- Then on to Antioch of Pisidia. Paul and Barnabas visited Antioch on their first missionary journey, going to the synagogue on the Sabbath (the Jewish day of worship), and Paul was asked to speak to the congregation. In the Bible this is Paul's first recorded sermon.
- Visit the Church of St. Paul, the Roman Bath, Septimus Severus' triumphal gate, Temple of Augustus, and museum.
- We'll drive to Pamukkale for overnight. Tonight, swimming in the hotel's thermal pool to relax your body after a long day of travel.




DAY 07 PAMUKKALE - LAODICEA - PHILADELPHIA - SARDIS –IZMIR (SMYRANA)

Visit the Ancient City of Hierapolis, ancient Roman city, where St.
 Philip was martyred during the persecutions ordered by Domitian.
 You can see the famous natural wonder white cotton fortress, the thermal springs.

DAY 08 IZMIR - EPHESUS - IZMIR B, L, D

- Visit the ruins of Ephesus where St. Paul lived and preached for more than two and a half years
 and to where he subsequently sent his letter to the Ephesians. We see the Baths of Scholastica,
 the Library of Celsus, the Temple of Hadrian, the theater, the Double Church (The Church of
 Mary).
- Visit **House of Virgin Mary**. At the third Ecumenical Council on 431 A.D. in Ephesus, it was claimed that Mary came to Ephesus with St. John in 37 A.D. and lived there until her death in 48 A.D.
- Visit Leather Production Centre fashion show by professional trained models.
- Visit Basilica of St.John, it is believed that the evangelist St. John had spent his last years in the region around Ephesus and buried in the southern slope of Ayosolug Hill.
- Drive back to Izmir (Smyrna), the third largest city in Turkey and one
 of the sites of the Seven Churches of Asia (Rev. 2:12-17). Smyrna is a
 city scarred with a bloody history of trade and warfare.
- Visit St Polycarp Church.
- Check in and overnight in Izmir.

DAY 09 THYTIRA - PERGAMUM B, L, D










- Visit **Thyatira** (*Rev. 2: 18-28*), you will see the ruins of an ancient commercial center, located in the fertile valley where the trade route passed.
- Visit Acropolis (High City) the steepest of the ancient world. Revelation 2:12-16 describes the city as "where Satan's seat is," a reference to the altar of Zeus, where we pause for reflection on the fulfillment of Scripture.
- Visit the Red Basilica; once a pagan temple, it later converted into a Christian church.
- Walk thru the Pergamum Asklepion, the famous medical center of antiquity.
- Dinner and overnight in **Pergamum**.

DAY 10



- Drive to Troas, founded about 300 B.C. by one of the generals of Alexandria the Great. During the Apostle Paul's second missionary journey, it was from Troas that he received the "Macedonian call" to Europe. This is where Luke's account changes from "they" to "we" (Acts 16:6-12), indicating that he joined Paul's team at Troas. Returning from Macedonia during his third journey, Paul was in Troas for a week, when the young man Eutychus fell from the third loft as Paul preached. Paul soon walked some thirty miles to Assos.
- We will follow the apostle's footstep. You will walk the old marketplace of Assos and see the council chamber and Temple of Athena.
- Visit Ruin City of Troy—legendary by Homer's story of Helen and the Trojans' wooden horse.
- Dinner and overnight in Canakkale.



- Drive to **Nicaea**, you will see remains of Constantine's palace, now covered by the water at the shore of **Lake Iznik**. It was here in this palace chapel that the First Ancient Church Council convened in A.D. 325 to produce the Nicene Creed. Enjoy **Nicaea's St. Sophia Church**, where the Seventh Church Council convened in 787 A.D.
- Continue to Istanbul.
- Dinner and overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 12 ISTANBUL - DEPARTURE B, L, D

- Visit Topkapi Palace, was not only the residence of the Ottoman sultans, but also the administrative and educational center of the state.
- The **Grand Bazaar** where is one of the largest and oldest covered markets in the world.
- Chora Church and Museum, where the mosaics are breathtaking.
 You are going to see well-preserved wall mosaics from 14th century
 A.D.
- Transfer to Istanbul Airport for your departure flight.


