


DAY 01	DEPARTURE FROM KUALA LUMPUR	Meals on Board		
Depart from Kuala Lumpur to Istanbul, Turkey.				
DAY 02	ISTANBUL arrival - CANAKKALE	B. L. D		

- Arrived Istanbul, meet and assist by our English-speaking guide.
- Drive to Canakkale via the **Dardanielle Straits**.
- Check-in to Hotel in Canakkale, for dinner and overnight.

DAY 03	CANAKKALE - TROY - PERGAMON	B. L. D

- Visit Ruin City of Troy legendary by Homer's story of Helen and the Trojans' wooden horse.
- Drive to Pergamon.
- Visit Acropolis (High City) the steepest of the ancient world.
 Revelation 2:12-16 describes the city as "where Satan's seat is," a reference to the altar of Zeus, where we pause for reflection on the fulfillment of Scripture.
- Check-in to Hotel in Pergamon, for dinner and overnight.



- Visit **Thyatira** (*Rev. 2: 18-28*), you will see the ruins of an ancient commercial center, located in the fertile valley where the trade route passed.
- Visit House of Virgin Mary. At the third Ecumenical Council on 431 A.D. in Ephesus, it was
 claimed that Mary came to Ephesus with St. John in 37 A.D. and lived there until her death in 48
 A.D.
- Visit Leather Production Centre fashion show by professional trained models.
- Visit the ruins of Ephesus where St. Paul lived and preached for more than two and a half years and to where he subsequently sent his letter to the Ephesians. We see the Baths of Scholastica, the Library of Celsus, the Temple of Hadrian, the theater, the Double Church (The Church of Mary).
- (The Church of Mary).

 Visit Basilica of St.John, it is believed that the evangelist St. John had spent his last years in the region around Ephesus and buried in the southern slope of Ayosolug Hill.
- Drive to Izmir (Smyrna), the third largest city in Turkey and one of the sites of the Seven
 Churches of Asia (Rev. 2:12-17). Smyrna is a city scarred with a bloody history of trade and warfare.
- Check-in to Hotel in **Izmir**, for dinner and overnight.






















DAY 05 | IZMIR (SMYRNA) - SARDES - PHILADELPHIA - LAODICEA - PAMUKKALE

Drive to Pamukkale.

 Visit Sardes the dead church. Remember 'you seem alive, but you are actually dead'.







• Visit **Pamukkale (Hierapolis)**, Thermal Terraces in Pamukkale.

• Check into hotel in **Pamukkale** (use the thermal pool in hotel), for dinner and overnight.

DAY 06 PAMUKKALE - YALVAC – KONYA - CAPPADOCIA B, L, D

- Visit Yalvac to visit Psidian Antioch where St Paul's first and longest recorded sermon was delivered at the synagogue.
- Drive to Cappadocia through Konya an ancient city in central Turkey once known as Iconium.
- Uchisar Castle from outside, which is the highest and the most dominant point, giving us a breathtaking panorama.
- Check-in to Hotel in Cappadocia, for dinner and overnight.

DAY 07 CAPPADOCIA B, L, D

- Early morning, you may take an optional Hot Air Balloon tour.
- Visit Ozkonak Underground City. A supernormal and amazing masterpiece.
- Visit a local weaving center to see carpets and kilims of the country.
- See the local stones like Sultanite and Turquoise and have some free time for shopping.
- Visit the Goreme Open Air Museum, where you will enjoy the fantastic rock churches and beautiful frescos from various centuries decorating the walls of the churches.
- Visit Pigeon Valley. Pigeons have been always important for Cappadocian people. That's why people carved some pigeon houses to keep them in certain places.
- Devrent and Monk's Valley, to see the extraordinary mushroomshaped rock pinnacles or 'fairy chimneys'.
- Check-in to Hotel in **Cappadocia**, for dinner and overnight.

DAY 08 CAPPADOCIA - ISTANBUL B, L, D

- Transfer airport for flight to Istanbul.
- Visit the **Hippodrome**, where chariot races and the Byzantine riots took place.
- The Mosque of Sultan Ahmet from outside no interior visit. Beautifully decorated with 21, 000 blue Iznik tiles, it is commonly known today as the Blue Mosque.
- The Grand Bazaar one of the largest and oldest covered markets in the world
- The Spice Bazaar (Egyptian Bazaar): The air here is filled with the enticing aromas of cinnamon, caraway, saffron, mint, thyme and every other conceivable herb.


